Free or Reduced Meals Eligibility Announcement

North Haven Public Schools has announced its policy for determining eligibility of children who may receive free or reduced meals served under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP).

For school year 2026-2027, reduced-price eligible students enrolled in a school participating in the School Breakfast Program will be able to receive a breakfast free of charge. Additionally, all students eligible for reduced-price meals enrolled in schools participating in the National School Lunch Program will be able to receive a lunch free of charge.
