LOST STREAM MAP

The STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW ENGLAND resembles another map-known to Pennsylvania anglers as the "Lost Stream Map."

It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee, a former Penn State Professor.

Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of 45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill.

But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in non-photographic blue. Higbee was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under lock and key.

Then, at the age of 91, Howard Higbee's dream came true. Computers made it possible to reprint the map.

Then the STREAM & LAKE MAP OF NEW ENGLAND was created.

North Haven to Become a Tourism Mecca



The Town of North Haven near former the New York, New Haven and Hartford Rail line west of the current CSX Rail Yard (known as the Western Hump Yard) with your help The Friends of Cedar Hill Yard create a working representation of the New Haven's Cedar Hill Rail Yard utilizing the existing tracks, buildings, tunnels, structures, light towers and artifacts.

Our Mission is to preserve and protect the History of THE NY, NH&HRR through Education, Information and Events related to how the Railroad served the Northeast. The New Haven RR helped to put the East Coast on the map with a State of the Art train car classification yard where rail cars from across the nation were sorted and assembled into trains for north and south destinations.

who's history must be preserved. Included in our plan will be preservation on wildlife and habitats, green space with picnic opportunities and in the nearby Quinnipiac River fishing and boating. We are attempting to get the Cedar Hill Yard on the State list of Historic places. An opportunity to accomplish that dissolved in an arson for in the mid '70's where the old roundhouses stood. That site is now a load out facility for a trucking company handling lumber.

The New Haven Railroad pioneered TOFC-Trailer on Flat Car means of

moving pre loaded trailers on trains where they were then driven to customers locally and throughout the neighboring states. The Interstate Highway System made the freight rail business obsolete.

"What goes around comes around". The current state of affairs has made shipping by rail an attractive alternative again. Railroads are making a comeback primarily by the Short Line Railroads who have taken over portions of the New Haven. Similarly that is happening all across the Nation.

There are already several Railroad Museums throughout CT, many have Fan Trips including the Essex Steam Railroad. No doubt there's a big interest in Railroading and because of The New Haven the State of CT is a destination for that purpose. The Friends of Cedar Hill Yard will become and enhance that experience! We endeavor to create a Railroad Museum Consortium in CT and perhaps become a model for other states across the Nation to do the same. Currently I am a sustaining Member of the New Haven Railroad Technical & Historical Association and Board Member/Secretary to the Friends of Cedar Hill Yard Working Group founded by President Matthew Chase who's dad worked on the New Haven back in the day.
