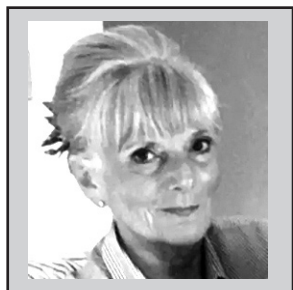
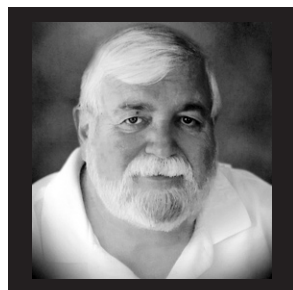


OBITUARIES

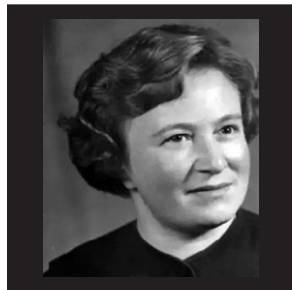

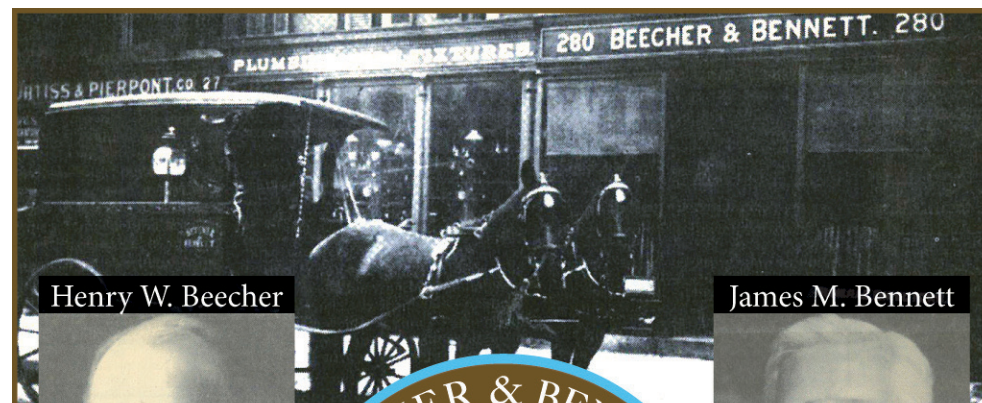
