### The GFWC Women's Club Hosted A Blood Drive At St. Frances Cabrini Church

**North Haven:** Connecticut is in the midst of a critical blood shortage. Increasing needs for blood across the state and the nation resulting from numerous climate driven disasters including tornados, forest fires, floods, and other tragedies coupled with the lack of donations have resulted in the critical shortage of blood. In order to help ameliorate this critical need the GFWC Women's Club of North Haven hosted a Blood drive on Wednesday, June 26 at St. Frances Cabrini Church on 57 Pond Hill Road in North Haven. The Drive ran from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. This blood drive was the 13th blood drive hosted by the Women's Club over the past decade.

Like all the other blood drives hosted by the Women's Club, members supplied home baked items and sandwiches for donors after donation. Along with its numerous other activities, the Women's Club works to make a difference in the community through community service projects as well as education and welcomes women 18 and over who wish to engage in public service projects which help meet public needs. Meetings are held at 10:00 a.m. on the first Friday of each month between September and June at the North Haven Senior Center at 189 Pool Road.

Women who wish to support their community by becoming involved in community activities serving others have numerous opportunities through the GFWC Women's Club of North Haven. The organization operates the "Little Free Library" on the grounds of the North Haven Congregational Church providing free books for children and adults, and continues to provide food donations to the Food Pantry of North Haven and North Haven's Community Services Program. The Women's Club supplies various items including toiletries, calendars and paperback books and treats for the Vets to the Veterans at the Veteran's Hospital in West Haven. Regular donations of diapers, wipes, baby clothes and other items are supplied to Mary and Joseph's Place for mothers in need. Numerous other service activities fill the yearly agenda of the Women's Club.



Just two weeks ago the Women's Club donated \$2,650.00, proceeds from a "Furry Friends" Raffle, to the Town of North Haven for use in North Haven's Animal Control Program.

The General Federation of Women's Clubs has been in existence since the 1890's and is an international organization with clubs across all the states in the United States and in many countries committed to volunteer community activities enhancing the lives of others.
