## Bobcats dominate the Bulldogs 8-0

Quinnipiac men's ice hockey took care of business on Saturday Feb. 7, dismantling the Yale Bulldogs 8-0 in the annual Battle of Whitney Ave.

Bobcat fans showed out loud and proud, filling the student section with a sea of white sporting "The Battle of Whitney Ave" t-shirts and signs reading "Go Bobcats."

"The crowd was just electric tonight, and the boys were just buzzing," Quinnipiac head coach Rand Pecknold said. "I thought the crowd was really important tonight."

Freshman forward Ethan Wyttenbach recorded his first collegiate hat trick, as he leads the nation with 47 points on 19 goals and 28 assists.

"(He) gives me the runway to make those plays and trust my instincts," Wyttenbach said about Pecknold "Obviously, I think it's worked out a bit the last couple games, finding open ice and especially getting some breakaways."

Sophomore defenseman Braden Blace led the squad with three assists in the contest.

The Bobcats played with speed and grit, outshooting the Bulldogs 35 to 23.
