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Additional Tax Benefits For Veterans 2026 Grand List Year

New Fairfield Veterans may be eligible for additional Veterans exemptions based on income. A signed application along with a 2025 Tax Return or all 1099's if a non-filer must be presented to the Assessor's office by October 1, 2026.

State program: Maximum 2025 income

• Single - \$46,300 - income includes Social Security

• Married - \$56,500 - income includes Social Security

Town Program: Maximum 2025 income

• Single - \$77,839 - income includes Social Security

• Married - \$86,909 - income includes Social Security

100% Disabled Veteran – not P&T

• Single - \$18,000 *

• Married - \$21,000 *

*For 100% Disabled Veterans, income does not include Social Security.

You must have the original honorable discharge papers, Form DD-214, recorded with the Town Clerk's Office by September 30th. Once the DD-214 is filed you do not have to file it again.

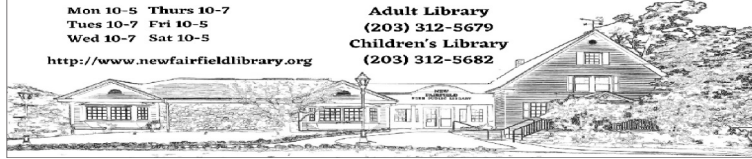
Applications for Additional Veteran's benefits are good for two years.
