YPU’s Party of the Right starts petition to change Pierson mascot back to the Slaves

In a recent Yale Political Union debate, representatives for the Yale Party of the Right declared that the Pierson Knights should go back to being the Pierson Slaves, the college’s mascot until 46 years ago.

“Naming things at a university is a statement of values, and we value the fact that Yale’s history is extremely connected to American slavery,” said the party chairman in his speech. “If it ain’t broke, don’t fix it.”

In a response speech, the Party of the Left countered that while they agreed the Knights is not a satisfactory mascot, it’s not because the mascot should be the Slaves, it’s because the Knights as a mascot excludes women and gender-non-conforming individuals who historically would not have been allowed to be Knights.
